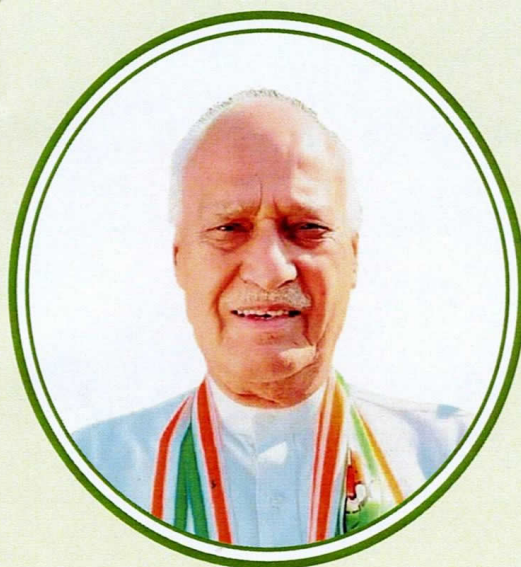

The Institution: An Introduction:

Govt. Arya Degree College, Nurpur, recognized under section **2(f) and 12(B) of the UGC Act 1956** is a constituent college of Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla and Sardar Patel University Mandi (SPU). This college was established as Arya College for girls in June, 1978 with a meager strength of 20 girls. The institution was started in the sacred memory of Swami Dayanand Saraswati whose name stands among the greatest social and religious reformers of modern India, who propounded that knowledge should be imparted without prejudice of caste, creed and sex and that the basic purpose of propagating real education is to inculcate love for Indian cultural ethics in consonance with the Vedic ideas of universal brotherhood.

The Arya College for girls was taken over by the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh on **25th June, 2002** as a co-educational institution and named as **Govt. Arya Degree College Nurpur**, with classes only in the subjects of Humanities. But, from the academic session 2009-10, this institution also started Science (Medical & Non- Medical) and commerce classes, thereby fulfilling the long standing demand and aspirations of the people of this area.

The University Grants Commission launched an employment oriented scheme on skill development as a part of College/ university education. This vocational degree programme (B. Voc.) started in our college w.e.f. June 2017 with two courses having 40 seats each, one in 'Retail Management' and other in 'Hospitality & Tourism'.

Having made a mark on the educational horizon of the Himachal Pradesh University, our college strives to create an environment conducive to continuous academic, co-curricular activities and holistic development of students as well as staff members. For this purpose, consistent efforts are made by all stakeholders to foster, encourage and motivate ideas and put them into practice. College tries to inculcate all the values, enshrined in our constitution i.e. value of liberty, equality, justice and brotherhood. We encourage a sense of tolerance for different cultures and opinions among our students.

With the purpose of consistently improving and innovating the teaching learning process and chasing our aim to make it more students centric, we emphasize on best practices and quality learning through hands on experience, project works and research. Besides hunting the talent galore in our students, the primal focus is a priority at all times, enlightenment of the next generation of our country. Students are encouraged to reflect upon interpreting meaningful social issues concerning the social milieu with a view to have a better interaction with community and to promote involvement and participation through social awareness programmes like : **National Service Scheme, Eco Club, National Cadets Corps, Red Ribbon Club, Rovers and Rangers, Road safety club and Women Grievance Redressal Cell.**

The faculty of Govt. Arya Degree College, Nurpur is valued for its **academic expertise, professional competence, proactive approach and pedagogic initiatives along with extending quality education to the students.** The faculty members also help them to develop constructive ideas, ethical and humanitarian values and a deep sense of responsibility towards society. During this session, several faculty members have been taking part in faculty development programmes, workshops and other academic activities that may keep them updated with the latest knowledge and information in their respective fields.

Red Ribbon Club AIDS Awareness:
